My Break

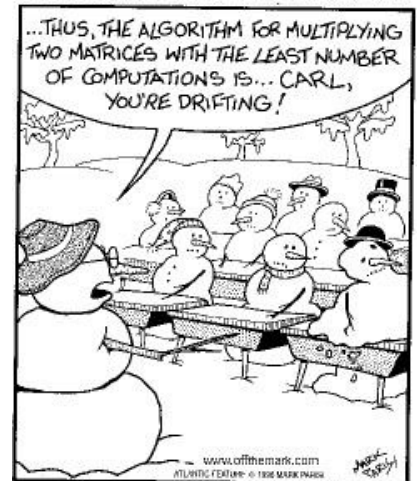
